

NWR Short Story 2015 Terms and Conditions

1. The competition is free to NWR fully paid up members.
2. We accept submissions from any fully paid up NWR member.
3. The title is 'Freedom' and this is open to the interpretation of the writer.
4. You may enter the competition as many times as you wish.
5. Stories must be unpublished, up to 2000 words and entirely your own original work. Your entry must not be submitted for publication or to other competitions when entering this NWR competition. If a story is discovered to have been entered elsewhere then the story will be disqualified.
6. Each story should be typed and double spaced and each page consecutively numbered.
7. Once submitted no corrections can be made.
8. ALL entries should be submitted by e-mail to: office@nwr.org.uk under the heading 'Short Story Competition.' Include your name and contact details in the e-mail (but not in the story).
9. The closing date for receipt of entries to the competition is midnight on 30th June 2015.
10. We cannot be responsible for postal or electronic disruptions. The deadline date is final.
11. We cannot hold any responsibility for incomplete or illegible entries.
12. All entries should be in English.
13. Entries will not be returned.
14. Entries should be the work of the author and not a translation or adaptation or copy of someone else's work.
15. Copyright remains with the entrant. However, by submitting the entry we have the unrestricted right to publish in our magazine and/or online.
16. Trustees and employees are not eligible to enter.
17. Entries containing unacceptable indecent, defamatory or discriminatory language, pornographic or other unlawful content shall not be considered.
18. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.

19. We do not disclose the number of entries.
20. By entering this competition each entrant agrees to be bound by these terms and conditions.
21. We reserve the right to reject any entry that does not comply.
22. The prize: Bed and breakfast for two at Gladstone's Library, Flintshire, CH53DF, near Chester and North Wales.
23. The prize must be taken before the end of December 2015 unless stated otherwise.
24. The winner of the competition will be notified by e-mail, 'phone or by letter. If no response is forthcoming within 14 days, the prize will be offered to the runner-up. Should the winner be unable to take the prize, we reserve the right to offer the prize to the runner-up. No alternative will be offered.
